The P.C believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and be encouraged to be open in sharing any concerns or complaints they may have about any aspect of the club with any member of the P.C committee.

As a young player of the club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

- All young players must play within the laws of the game and respect all officials and their decisions.
- All young players must show respect for other young players in the club and opponents.
- All young players should keep to agreed times for sessions and competitions, and inform the appropriate person if they are going to be late.
- If, having been selected for a competition or match, a young player is unable to participate in the event, they must inform the appropriate person immediately.
- All young players must wear appropriate badminton sports clothing for club sessions and competitions.
- All young players must pay any fees for training and events promptly or by the due date.
- Young players are not permitted to smoke, consume alcohol or take any drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club. (Players who are required to take prescribed medicine must discuss this with the P.C Child Welfare Officer. Nigel Phillips)
